



Know all men by these Presents that I Merrick Hornington of Greenville District and State aforesaid in consideration of the sum of four hundred dollars to me paid by Pleasant Earley of the District aforesaid have granted bargained and sold & released and by these Presents do grant bargain sell & release unto the said Pleasant Earley a Plantation or parcel of land lying and being in the District aforesaid on both sides of Morgans Creek water of middle Tyger River, beginning at a Pine and running thence West 42 chain to a Poplar, thence S. 50 chains to a Red Oak thence E. 42 ch. to a Red Oak, thence to the beginning containing two hundred and ten acres be the same more or less, granted by a Patent bearing date the 21 day of June 1784. to William Wood & by him Conveyed to Vincent Anderson & by him to John Robuck & by Robuck to John Whetton & by Whetton to the P. Hornington. Also one other tract a parcel of land joining the above, Beginning at a Red oak corner of the above tract running thence N. 80 E. 28.
