This Indenture made this tenth day of November on. thousand eight hundred and two and in the Twenty sixth year of American Independence between William Earley Sheriff of Greenville District & State of aforesaid of the one part, and Starling Ingram of the other part Witnesseth, Whereas Elias Earle Deceased was lately seized in fee Simple to him and his heirs for and two certain tracts or parcels of land Containing Four hundred and Thirty Six acres, be the same more or less. Situate lying and being in the District of aforesaid, one of the above Tracts Containing two hundred and Fifty Acres more or less lying and being on the Sink hole fork of Tyger River, Beginning at Obadiah Thompsons Corner on a red oak & running thence S. 27 ch. 54 Lk. to a black gum, thence E. 59 ch. 10. Lk. to a white oak, thence N 59 ch. 10. Lk. to a red oak, thence West 27 ch. 54 Lk. to a Stake, thence S. 31. Ch. 02 Lk. to a Stake, thence West to the Beginning - The other Tract containing One hundred and eighty six acres more or less, Situated in the District of aforesaid on the ^{Whanchoy} ~~West~~ side of South Tyger, and bounded by lines running S.
