Presents do grant bargain sell and Release unto the s^r W. D. Thomas all
that Tract or parcel of Land Containing seven acres being part of a Tract
of Two hundred and sixty seven acres of Land granted to the said John
Thomas on the sixteenth day of July One thousand seven and Eighty four
which said seven acres lies in the North West corner of said Tract of
two hundred & sixty seven acres and is cut off by a line North & South
from the lines of said Tract - Together with all and singular the
Rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to said seven acres
of Land belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining to have
and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto
the said W. D. Thomas his heirs and assigns for ever. And I do bind
myself my heirs executors & administrators (heirs) to warrant &
for ever defend all and singular the said Premises unto the said
W. D. Thomas his heirs and assigns against myself and my heirs
and against every other person whoms ever lawfully claiming or
to claim the same or any part thereof. Witness my hand and
Seal the fourth day of November in the year of our Lord one thousand
seven hundred and ninety nine & in the 24th year of the Inde-
pendence of the United States of America
