One Negro Woman named Moll & her children to have and to hold the said bargained Negroes to the said John Thomas Senr. his heirs & assigns for ever, to the only proper use and behoof of him the said John Thomas Senr. his heirs and assigns, and I the said John Thomas Junr. my heirs executors and administrators the said Negro woman & children unto the said John Thomas Junr. his heirs & assigns will warrant & for ever defend by these Presents - In Testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal the 8th day of April A. D. 1797.
