

This Indenture made this Twenty fifth day of January
in the year of our Lord Christ, Eighteen hundred and four
between William Whorton of the State of South Carolina and
District of Pendleton of the one part; and Anthony ^{Joseph} Griffen, both
of State and District before mentioned of the other part, Witnesseth
that I the said William Whorton for and in consideration
of the sum of One thousand Dollars to me in hand paid by the
before named Anthony Griffen and Joseph Griffen the Receipt
whereof I do hereby acknowledge Do by these Presents bargain
sell deliver Convey and Confirm unto the afore named Anthony
Griffen and Joseph Griffen their Heirs and Assigns for ever, a certain
Tract or Parcel of lands Containing by estimation Five hundred
Acres Situate lying and being in the District of Greenville and
State of ~~South Carolina~~ mentioned land on both sides of Mountain Creek
and on the Branches of Buckhorn Creeks, which Creeks are waters of
Enore River, bounded as follows, to wit, Beginning on Robert M. a fee
line, on the N. side of Mountain Creek, thence on his line Crossing said
Creek thence leaving his line and ~~leaving~~ ^{crossing} up said Creek on South
side thereof & crossing the same and running as M. C. hand his line
to the before mentioned Hollum's Survey thence Running as the Plat to
the beginning &c. Three hundred Acres of the aforesaid was granted to
Wadsworth and Turpin the first day of January 1787. by his
Excellency William Moultrie Esq. and Decided to the said
William Whorton by Wadsworth and Turpin the 20th July 1791.
The other two hundred Acres granted to James Hollom the 7th of
January 1793. and decided to Mr. Whorton by Ephraim Reed 1801. as will
more fully appear by the different Plats annexed to the said Grants
both joining in form as before mentioned. Together with all
Orchards, fences, houses, out houses, Gardens, Wood, waters or water
Courses mines, minerals, hereditaments and appurtenances thereto
belonging or in any wise appertaining thereto. To have & to hold
unto the said Griffens them their heirs Exor.^s Adm.^s & assigns, and I the
said William Whorton, do Covenant and agree with the said
Anthony Griffen and Joseph Griffen that I will for myself my
Heirs Exor.^s Adm.^s &c. will warrant and for ever defend the above
mentioned land and Premises unto the said Anthony Griffen
and Joseph Griffen and to their heirs and assigns from the
