

Know all men by these Presents that I John Ford of Livingston County &  
State of Kentucky for and in consideration of one dollar to me in hand  
paid by William Ford son of John Ford Dec. of Greenville District & State  
of South Carolina the Receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge, Have granted  
bargained sold ~~and~~ release conveyed & confirmed and by these Presents do grant  
bargain sell ~~and~~ release convey & confirm unto the said William Ford  
his heirs or assigns all that Plantation or Tract of land containing one  
hundred and fifty "acres" be the same more or less, Situate in Spartanburg  
District and State of South Carolina on the North and North East side of  
Enoree River including the mouth of Liska Creek of said river bounded  
Southwardly by Enoree River, all other sides by vacant land at the time  
of the Survey being made, and granted to James Ford by Grant bearing  
date the Seventh day of March One thousand seven hundred &  
Sixty nine, and runs as follows (that is to say) Beginning on a Hickory  
on Enoree River, thence North three degrees East Seventy Seven chains &  
forty four links to a White Oak, thence South Eighty Seven degrees East nine  
teen Chains and thirty Seven links to a White Oak, thence South three  
degrees West Seventy Seven chains forty four links to a Stake on said River &  
thence up the meanders of said River to the beginning. Together with all and  
singular the Woods waters water Courses improvements privileges, ad-  
vantages hereditaments and appurtenances to the said Premises belonging  
or in any wise Incident or appertaining and all the Estate Right Title  
Interest and demand of myself my heirs Executors or Administrators
