Know all men by these Presents that I Aaron Mincey of this State and District aforesaid for and in consideration of the sum of Eighty dollars to me paid in hand the Receipt whereof is here by acknowledged have bargained and sold and by these Presents do grant bargain & sell and release unto Thomas Springfield his heirs &c a certain Tract & parcel of Land that Samuel Walker sold to said Mincey it lying and being on the waters of Annoe River begining at a Spanish Oak corner thence along conditional line to the Post Oak ^{"on the head of the branch between lands of S. Mincey's"} made by Walker and said "Mincey" then taking down the branch to a Red Oak corner thence taking along the old line to the branch whence taking up the branch to the begining, thence to the begining concluding the Plantation where S. Mincey now lives and with all and singular its Rights members hereditaments to S. Land and Premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining to the s^r. Springfield his heirs and assigns forever, & I do for my full warrant and defend a good lawful right & title to said Land & Premises against myself my heirs and all other claims whatsoever or in any part thereof in witness whereof I hereunto set my hand and seal this fifth day of October eighteen hundred and three.
