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This Indenture made this seventh day of November 1797. Between Archer Atkins of Richland County Camden District South Carolina of the one part, and Joshua Owens of Greenville County Washington District of the other part. Witnesseth that the said Atkins for and in consideration of Forty pounds Sterling money to him in hand paid the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath granted bargained sold and delivered unto the said Joshua Owens, and by these Presents doth grant bargain sell alien and confirm unto the said Owen unto the said Owen all that Tract or Parcel or tract of Lands containing 418 acres of land laying on Peters Creek Greenville County the waters of Enoree, beginning at a Post Oak at Shumake's corner, thence along the original line to a Post Oak corner, thence N 10 E 50 to a black Jack corner, thence N 80 E 25. 00 to a stake, thence N 23 50 to a pine, thence N 16 40. 880, to Shumake's line it being part of a tract of land containing 562 "acres" granted to said Atkins dated the 13th day of October 1785 by his excellency W^m Moultrie, and Recorded in Grant Book F F F F. p. 100. and I the said Archer Atkins doth convey unto S. Owens all singular the ways woods water and water courses easements profits commodities advantages emoluments rights members and appurtenances whatsoever unto the said Tract of 418 acres of land belonging or in any ways appertaining whatsoever unto the said Tract and the Rovision and Reversion remainder and remainders rents and issues & every part and parcel and also all the estate ~~rights~~ Interest property claim and demand both in law and Equity of him the said Atkins to the S. Owens of in & to the same to have and to hold the said Tract of 418 acres and I the said Archer Atkins doth warrant and defend the said Tract of Land from me and my heirs and from all persons right titles, claiming and demanding whatsoever and I the said Atkins doth warrant and defend the same forever unto the said Owen & his heirs for ever.
