and Sold and Relased and by these presents do grant Bargain Sell and Relase unto the
Said Toab Hoadl in his aforesaid possession a plantation or tract of Land, lying and
being in Greenville District on the wildcat Creek of South Tyger river. Begining on
a post oak Runing N. 75 E. 89th to a Black Jack thence S. 20 E. 61th 75th to a post oak
thence S. 70 W. 44th 50th to a large Hickory thence N. 18 W. 99th 20th to the begining
Post oak. Containing by estimation one hundred and eighty two acres the same being
a tract of Land granted to Samuel Shaw on the twenty fifth day of January in
the year one thousand seven hundred and eighty four and the said tract of Land at the
Instane of John D Young^{100th} Condered and sold by the County Court of Greenville and purchased by
Baylis Earles and by order of Said Court John Hunt Esqr. then Sheriff made on the titles
refrence to the Clerks office being had will fully appear containing by estimation one hundred and
eighty two acres more or less the same being the plantation whereon the Said Hoadl now lives —
Together with all and Singular the rights members Headstronments and Appertanments unto
