Know all men by these Presents that I William Scott of Greenville County and State aforesaid in consideration of the sum of two hundred and thirty Dollars to me in hand paid by Isaac Lovells of the County and State aforesaid have granted Bargained sold & Released & by these presents do grant bargain sell and Release unto the s^d Isaac Lovells all that plantation or tract of Land Which he now lives on Situate in the County aforesaid lying on the waters of Mountain Creek of Saluda River containing one thousand and twenty eight acres to the same more or less beginning on a Maple 3/4 running thence N 76 E 54 50 on John Matlocks line to a stake 3/4 thence South 19 West 9 chains on s^d Matlocks line to a stake x thence East 12 50 on land laid out to Hendrick Arnold decess^d thence North 21 1/2 chains on W^m Jones line to a road oak 3/4 thence South 67 1/2 W. 2 1/2 on Obadiah Estes line to a road oak x near the head of a branch thence down the meanders of said branch
