Know all men by these Presents that I William Scott of Greenville County and State aforesaid in consideration of the sum of two hundred and thirty Dollars to me in hand paid by Isaac Lovelis of the County and State aforesaid have granted Bargained Sold & Released by these presents to grant bargain sell and Release unto the s<sup>r</sup> Isaac Lovelis all that plantation or tract of Land which he now lives on situated in the County aforesaid lying on the waters of Mountain Creek of Saluda River containing one hundred and twenty eight acres to the same more or less begining on a Maple tree running thence N. 76 E. 64. 50 on John Mathews line to a stake & thence South 19° West 9 chains on s<sup>r</sup> Mathews line to a stake & thence East 12. 50 on land laid out to Hendrick Arnold about thence North 21 May 64. 50 on John Jones line to a Red oak 3 x thence South 67 W. 24. 50 on Hendrick Estes line to a red oak X near the head of a branch thence down the course of said branch
