E. 45^o 40' to a corner stake, thence S. E. 45^o 40' to a corner stake, thence S. W. 45^o 40' to a corner ash which is on the Indigo dam branch, thence up the said branch to its head and with a line of marked Trees to the beginning. Bounding on Judge Pindletons land to the S. E, S. W. and on all other sides vacant at the time of Surveying, Containing one Hundred and sixty acres more or less — Together with all and singular the rights members Hereditaments and appertinances to the S. d premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining.
