Lawrence District in the State aforesaid in consideration of one hundred Dollars to me in hand
paid by Berry Hollon of Greenville District and State aforesaid have granted, Bargained sold
and Released and by these presents do grant, bargain sell and Release, unto the s^t d Berry
Hollon a plantation or tract of Land containing one hundred acres of land (Be the same more
less) situate in Greenville District lying on the Branches of horse Creek waters of ready
run Beginning on an ash tree, on a branch running thence S 40 E. 30 on Henry Hills
line to a Red oak 3X on the old Indian line thence S 47 W. 21. 50. on said line to a pine 3X.
on Nathaniel Whitlocks line thence N 42 W. 55. on said Whitlocks and Thomas Hollon
lines to a stake 3X thence N 52 E. 14. on John Lovelife's line to a stake 3X thence S 49
E. 21. on James Lovelife's to a stake Near a branch thence down said branch to the beginning
(Being part of a tract of 996 acres of Land originally granted to the said Samuel
Neighbours) Together with all and singular the Rights, members Hereditaments,
and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appur-
tenant. To have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the
said Berry Hollon his heirs and assigns forever. And I do hereby bind myself my heirs
executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said
premises unto the said Berry Hollon his heirs and assigns against myself and my heirs
and against every other person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same
or any part thereof. Witness my hand and seal this Nineteenth day of January
in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and three and in the Twenty
Seventh year of the Independency of the United States of America —
