Thirty two acres the same more or less lying on the waters of Ready Creek and

line 299 chain to a Stake in Alexander Raynor line thence S. 39 W. 7. 50 to a Stake
thence South 38 chain 50 links on said Raynor line to a post oak thence N. 75
W. 25 Ch. 50 links to a post oak on Jacob Reasonover line thence along Reasonover
line to the begining To have & to hold the aforesaid bargained premises with all
