The state of South Carolina Know all men by these presents that we My Penning and Christian his wife of the state aforesaid in the District of Greenville, in consideration of the sum of seven hundred & fifty dollars to us paid by Samuel Williams of the District and state aforesaid have granted, bargained, sold & released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the s<sup>d</sup> Samuel Williams a tract or parcels of land lying in the District aforesaid at the mouth of the grave Creek, begining on a stake Bx on Saluda river, thence North 20° E. 39. 96. White oak Bx thence S. 70° E. 39. 54 to Lake Bx - thence S. 20° W. 63. 42. to Stake Bx thence N. 65° W. to a tree 3x on the river thence up the meanders of the said river to the begining containing one hundred and ninety acres originally granted to Lewis Gaffin by his Excellency W<sup>m</sup> Moultrie ant<sup>the</sup> day of August 1795 reference being thereto had well more fully appeard also a small tract lying on the side of the above tract begining on a small hickey 3x. thence S. 70° E. 10 to a pine 3x. thence S. 20° W. 25. to a post oak Bx. thence N. 70° W. 10. to a stake Bx thence to the begining containing twenty five acres being the s<sup>d</sup> Christians portion Dower of a tract of land originally granted to Boxley Roach (Dumas) Together with all and singular the premises above mentioned with the rights, member, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining To have & to hold all & singular the premises before mentioned unto the s<sup>d</sup> Samuel Williams his heirs and assigns and we do hereby bind our selves our heirs Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the s<sup>d</sup> premises
