State of S<sup>t</sup> Carolina - Know all men by these presents that I David McDavid of Greenville District in the State afores<sup>d</sup> for sum consideration of the sum of one hundred pounds to me in hands paid by Joel Reed of the District & State afores<sup>d</sup> have granted bargained sold & released & by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Joel Reed a plantation or tract of one hundred acres of lands being apart of a tract of six hundred & forty acres originally granted to John Redmon by patent bearing date the twenty first day of January one thousand seven hundred Eighty five laying and being on a Creek called Durbin Creek in the State afores<sup>d</sup>. Recorded in Secretary office in the Book CCC Page 4915. Beginning on a maple on S.<sup>th</sup> Creek running thence N. 15 E. with S.<sup>th</sup> old line of S.<sup>th</sup> tract then S. 75 E. 54 chains to stake on S.<sup>th</sup> line then S. 15 W. 54 chains to hickory on S.<sup>th</sup> Creek then down the various courses of the Creek to the beginning same to contain one hundred acres more or less. Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments & appertainances to the S.<sup>th</sup> premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining To have & to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto Joel Reed his heirs & assigns forever & I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors & administrators to warrant & forever defend all & singular the S.<sup>th</sup> premises unto Joel Reed his heirs and assigns against my heirs & against every other Person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same on any part thereof - In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 3<sup>rd</sup> day of April in the year of our Lord 1807 - Signed
