these presents that I George Godwin and Mary my wife of said State  
& District for and in consideration of the sum of three hundred Dollars  
to us in hand paid by Arthur Clark of Greenville District and State  
aforesaid do grant and bargains sold & release & by these presents  
do grant bargain sell & release unto the said Arthur Clark one certain  
piece or parcel of land situated lying and being in Greenville District  
& on the north side of Saluda river Beginning at rear Oak running N. 70°  
E. 57 chains to a post Oak & thence S. 20° E. 12° 50' to a lightwood Stake  
& thence S. 40° W. 20 chains to lighted Stake & thence S. 50° E. 20° to a post Oak &  
thence N. 40° W. 38 chains to the river - also fifty acres more or less contained by  
Harry Langford to me the above George Godwin Beginning on Saluda  
River
