unto the said Abraham Mayfield all that Tract or parcel of Land, supposed to contain,
one hundred & eighty one acres, it being the same tract of Land conveyed from Jacob Bunting
the said Benjamin Farmer, situate on the N. side of Enoree river in the State & District
of said Bunting's Ballingers old tract, also, said Mayfield & William Taylor, which
includes the Land to be conveyed, to the same man or his, Together with all & singular the
rights, Members, Heraldments & appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise
incident or appertaining. To have and to hold all & singular the premises before
mentioned unto the said Abraham Mayfield his heirs & assigns forever & I do hereby
bind myself my heirs Executors & Administrators to Warrant & forever defend
all & singular the said premises unto the said Abraham Mayfield his heirs & assigns
against myself my heirs & against all other person or persons whomsoever lawfully
