


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The State of South Carolina Know all men by these presents that I James Tenant of Greenville District & State aforesaid for & in consideration of the sum of Four hundred & Thirty four Dollars ninety two cents & a halfe to me paid by Thomas Paine of the same Place hath Granted bargained sold & delivered & by these presents Do Grant bargain sell & deliver unto the s<sup>t</sup> Thomas Paine one certain tract or parcel of Land Containing eighty four & one third acres situated in Greenville District on the Golden Grove Creek it being part of a tract of Land Originally Granted to John Bowes begining at a white Oak corner on Isaac Wests line and running on Matthias Richardson's line 27 ch<sup>t</sup> 11 to a white Oak corner on a branch thence 13<sup>c</sup> 60 with said line to a sweet Gum Corner on the Grove Creek and thence 29 down said creek to a white Oak corner & from thence 23<sup>c</sup> to a red oak corner on Isaac Wests line & from thence 2<sup>c</sup> 76 to a corner stake & from thence 26<sup>c</sup> to the begining and Likewise a certain tract or parcel of land situated in Greenville District on a branch of the Golden Grove Creek containing forty acres more or less it being part of a certain tract of land Granted unto John Bowes Beginning on a corner with Oak on Isaac Wests line & thence N 28<sup>c</sup> E 17 to a corner Stake and thence N 58<sup>c</sup> W 29<sup>c</sup> to a corner Stake on the original line & thence S 44<sup>c</sup> W 13<sup>c</sup> to Isaac Wests corner Stake & from thence to the begining for the consideration of two hundred & three Dollars 88 Cents. Together with all & singular the rights & members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining To have and to hold all & singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Thos Paine his heirs & assigns forever and I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors and administrators to warrant & forever defend all & singular the premises aforesaid unto the said Thomas Paine his heirs & assigns Against myself & my heirs & against all other persons or persons who or whom lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof - Witness my hand this twenty seventh day of Nov<sup>r</sup> 1804 and in the twenty eighth year of the independence of the United States of America
