Geo. Grayham Conveyed by a Deed unto the Solomon Office on the twenty eighth day of November in the year one thousand seven hundred and ninety seven & by the S. Solomon Office Conveyed by a Deed unto the said Archibald Holcombe on the sixteenth day of February in the year one thousand seven hundred & ninety nine Beginning on a red Oak tree between Archibald Holcombe & Amble Riving three Shales so a hickory corner made when Graham Randles Land was laid off a part of the original tract thence along Randles line to a maple corner thence along Stephen Bills line as it goes to the old line at a sowerwood corner made when Bills part was laid off thence along the old line to a redwood corner on a red oak thence to a post Oak corner thence straight to the Beginning corner containing one hundred acres more or less, Together with all and singular the titles Hereditaments & appurtenances to the S. premises belonging or in any wise appertaining To have and to hold all & singular the premises before mentioned unto the S.
