


This Indenture made this sixteenth day of November in the Year of our Lord one thousand Eight hundred & four between George Saunders of the one part and Joseph M. Goughlan of the other part both of the District of Greenville & State of S. Carolina. Witnesseth that the said George Saunders for & in Consideration of two hundred dollars to him in hand paid by the said Joseph M. Goughlan the Receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged in Consideration of the same the said George Saunders - Hath bargained & Sold and by these presents Doth bargain sell & Deliver unto the said Joseph M. Goughlan a certain tract or parcel of land containing two hundred acres be the same more or less lying & being in the District of Greenville & State of S. Carolina and on the premises Creek Originally granted to Tho. Bell it being part of S. tract Beginning on a post oak 3x it being Cras & Saunders Corner turning thence with the post said oak for John Wilson to the stakes Corner 3x, and to the same corner to the west line of said land, thence S. 30 W. across the branch of S. Creek 54 ch. to a red oak 3x thence S. 55. E. 55 ch. 75 links to a stake corner 3x near a pine thence E. 22. ch. 50 links to the Beginning To have and To Hold all & singular the premises above mentioned unto the said Joseph M. Goughlan all & singular the rights, liberties, Acciditaments & appurtenances rights to the said premises in any wise ancient or appertaining. & the said Geo. Saunders doth hereby bind myself, my heirs, Executors & Assigns to warrants & power against the premises above mentioned unto the said Jo. M. Goughlan his heirs & assigns against all persons whomsoever lawfully claiming the same or any part thereof - ~~Power~~ -
