Witness my hand & seal this fifth day of June anno Domini 1805.)

280 South Carolina, I know all men by these presents that William Davis of Spartanburg District In consideration of the sum of one hundred Dollars to me paid by Philip Mabray of Greenville District I have granted bargained sold & released and by these presents Do grant bargain sell & release unto the said Philip Mabray a plantation or tract of land lying in Greenville District on both sides of the south fork of South Tygar River, Bounds N.E. on land laid off to Mary Harmon on all other sides vacant land. Beginning on a poplar running thence S. 30. E. 37. 20 to a Stake thence N. 83. W. 27. to a red Oak thence N. 45. 10 to a dogwood thence N. 80. W. 18. to a chestnut thence N. 19. to a hickory thence E. 27. W. to the Beginning corner by Elamation & forty four acres to the same more or less, the same being a tract of land granted to me by a patent bearing date the fifth day of July one thousand seven hundred and eighty six. Together with all & singular the rights, numbers, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise Appertaining To Have and To Hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Philip Mabray his heirs and assigns forever. And I do hereby bind myself my heirs, executors & administrators to warrant and defend all singular these premises unto the said Philip Mabray his heirs & assigns against myself & my heirs & executors every person howsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof, In witness whereof I the said William Davis
