 -all forks of Saluda river in the State and County aforesaid. Beginning at a black gum
 stake on the north side of the said Branch three S. 35. W. 70. and Oak 15. 75. Thence S. 69.
 W. 3. Red C. 16. 0. Thence N. 27. 10. 3 Chesnut 18. 0. Thence N. 20. E. 3. Hickory 25. 50.
 Thence S. 73. E. 3. Stake 37. 0. Thence to the Beginning Containing one hundred & twenty six acres
 more or less. Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments & appurtenan-
 ces to the said premises or in any wise incident or appertaining. To Have and To Hold
 all & singular the premises before mentioned unto the said William Carr his heirs & assigns for
 ever & I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors or administrators to warrant & defend all
 & singular the said premises unto the said unto the William Carr his heirs & assigns Against my
 self my heirs & every other person or persons whomsoever lawfully claiming or to be claimed



 Sterling money to me in hand well & truly paid at & before the sealing and delivery of these presents
 by James Kelly of said County the Receipt thereof is hereby fully acknowledged have granted
 bargain sold & released and by these presents. Doth grant bargain and sell and confirm unto him
 the s^r James Kelly him his heirs and assigns forever the following property. Viz. Seven Neg-
 roes Slaves first Dinah a negro woman about thirty five years old, second a July a Negro
 man about thirty years old, third Isabel a negro woman about thirty years old, fourth will
 a Negro man near fifty years old, fifth Mary a negro woman about thirty years old =
 Sixth Peter & Sarah a negro man and woman, also two Oxen ten head of Sheeps on beaver
 bay horse, one dark grey horse one brown mare, one hundred head of hogs Together with
 all my corn, one wagon & gears together with the tyer of two old waggon, one old riding
 chair and all my plantation tools with three thousand weight of bacon. Together
 with all singular the above mentioned premises unto him the said James Kelly him his
 heirs and assigns forever & the said Gershom Kelly shall & will against the legal claim of all
 and every person or persons whatsoever warrant & forever defende. As witness to the
 same I have hereunto set my hand & Seal this eighteenth day of April one thousand
 eight hundred & ninety four. . . .
