Know all men by these presents that we Archabald McMahon and Ann McMahon his wife for and in consideration of the sum of Five hundred Dollars to us in hand paid by Silas Holloway -

Heath Grants bargained sold confirmed & Released unto the said Silas Holloway all that tract of lands situate lying and being in the State of South Carolina in the District of Greenville on the waters of the Golden Grove containing one hundred Acres be the same more or less - by the Bounders hereafter mentioned Beginning at a Stake on Thompsons line thence S. 45 W. 35° chain along Holloways line to Joneses cor. Black Oak thence N. 88. 84. 43 E. 1/2 along Joneses line to Black Oak, thence N. 45 E. 40. 00 by the Meadow South to Thompsons line thence along Thompsons line to the Beginning -

The above mentioned lands on a branch of the Golden Grove creek Callias Yachery Branch - Together with all and singular the S. bargained Premises unto the said Silas Holloway & his lawfull Representatives in the said Arch. McMahon & Ann McMahon well warrant and fower defende against ourselves our heirs and Representatives and against every other person or persons lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part or parcels thereof -

In witness whereof we the said Archabald McMahon doth acknowledge the above bargained premises by affixing our hands and seals and delivering of the same this Thirtieth day of August one Thousand Eight hundred and five - and twenty ninth Year of American Independence.
