Richardson Esq^r the third day of March Eighteen hundred and four, Beginning at a black oak corner running N. 70. E. to a Road that leads from John Landreth to said Benson miles long said Road to a pine stump S. 0. W. to a stake corner thence S. 30 E. to the Beginning, containing thirty acres ~~more or less~~ together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said Premises before mentioned unto the said Arent Minsy his heirs and assigns forever & I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors & administrators to warrant and Ever Defend all and singular the S^d premises unto the said Arent Minsy his heirs and assigns against myself & my heirs & against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof

E. 95. to the corner by a chestnut from thence running N. 40. E. to a pine not corner made on the dividing line between the said John Buchanan and Lunford Hudson, from thence Along said dividing line to stake corner, from thence N. 10. W. 51. to the same Hudsons corner from thence S. 0. E. to stake corner, from thence 12. to stake corner, from thence N. S. 40. W. 07. to the Beginning corner it being part of a tract of Land containing Six hundred and forty acres (Granted)
