E. 52. chains on Shults Sullivants line to a white Oak st. thence East 8 chains on said Sullivants line to a post Oak st. N. 15. E. 7. 50 Links to a post Oak st. on the aforesaid Sullivants line thence N. 63. W. 27. ch. on Hudson Berrys line to a Stake st. thence N. 73. W. 25. chains on said Berrys line to a Stake st. thence S. 58. W. 31. ch. on Benjamin Townsons line ^{beginning st. on} to horse Creek thence down the meanders of said Creek a black Oak near the road thence along the said Benj^o Townsons line to a black on s^o Creek thence down the meanders of said Creek to
