 bargain Honey a certain tract or parcel of Lands unto John Justice Containing
 Eighty Acres be the same more or less, lying both sides of the Enow being part of the Old
 tract of Obediah Hooper at a pine Corner of Robert Prince Land thence along that
 Line across the river to a poplar Corner thence Jordan made thence down the meadow
 to a post Oak Corner then a Cross the river to a Road that goes from S^r Jordans to said
 Griffery. & thence to Corner on side Oaks thence along the Road to a Corner Spanish Oaks
 and from thence to the Beginning the same tract to contain Eighty Acres be the same more
 or less. Together with all and singular hereditaments and appurtenances to the said
 parcel of Land. And I do for my part warrant and well defende a good and Lawfull
 right to said Land me my heirs and assigns forever unto John Justice his heirs & assigns
 against the claim of myself Executors and administrators and every other person
 or persons laying any claim or title to the said Land. In Witness whereof I

 for and in Consideration of the sum of one hundred Dollars to him paid by the said
 William Rofs the receipt whereof is hereby Acknowledged, and the said Michael
 Miller. Have granted bargained, and sold unto the said W^m Rofs part of a tract of
 Land lying on a small Branch of mesh Creek a Branch of Tyger River Bounded
 by its own Lines bearing S.W. N.W. N.E. short line N.E. and South East all
 sides Vacant and unknown at the time of the Original Survey being made and
