lying in said District & State aforesaid, Beginning on a Stake comes 3t on the Ancient  
Boundary running with said boundary line S<sup>o</sup> 35° E<sup>o</sup> to a pine comes 3t thence N<sup>o</sup> 81 W<sup>o</sup> 18  
to a post oak 3t thence N<sup>o</sup> 52 W<sup>o</sup> 45° to a post oak 3t thence S<sup>o</sup> 88 W<sup>o</sup> 4° to a pine 3t on S.  
George Martin's land thence N<sup>o</sup> 24 W<sup>o</sup> 50 to a post oak on Joseph Thompson's lands thence  
W<sup>o</sup> 49 to red oak 3t thence N<sup>o</sup> 2 50 to a stake 3t thence E<sup>o</sup> 80 to a stake on Wm Choate's  
land to the Beginning stake come, Together with all singular the rights, members, hunc-  
taments & appurtenances to the said premises Belonging or in any wise Incident or appur-  
tenant. To have and to hold all singular the premises before mentioned unto the  
said W.B. Arnold his heirs & assigns forever, And I do hereby bind myself my  
heirs. Executors. And Administrators to warrant & forever defend all singular the  
premises to the said W.B. Arnold his heirs & assigns against myself & my heirs, and against  
every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof  
Witness my hands & seal this fourteenth day of January in the year of our Lord one thousand  
and eight hundred & six & in 30<sup>th</sup> year of American Independence.
