Have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell & release unto the said Thos. Terry part of tract of land that was originally granted to John Peden for 1759 acres by a grant bearing date the 6<sup>th</sup> day of November 1786 situate in the District aforesaid on the flat rock branch waters of Reedy River. Thence part of the tract conveyed to the said Burwell Mapsey now from said Mapsey to S<sup>r</sup>. Terry. Beginning on a Hickory tree running N. 86. W. 22. 50. to a red oak thence N. 10. W. 16 ch. to a Spanish Oak thence N. 56. W. 14. 50. to a Spanish oak thence N. 20. W. 31. 50. to a Stake thence N. 45. E. 39<sup>ch</sup> to a post oak thence S. 24. E. 22. 75 to a Stake thence S. 40. W. 16. to a B. Oak thence S. 25. E. 55. 40 to the Beginning all in that bounds for one hundred and fifty acres of land more or less. Together with all and singular the rights, members, fundaments & appurtenances to these premises belonging in any way incident or appertaining. To have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Thomas Terry his heirs and assigns forever, and I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Thos. Terry his heirs and assigns against myself and my heirs and against every person whom ever lawfully claimeth or to claim the same or any part thereof.
