State S^c Carolina Greenville District, I know all men by their persons that I Burrell Mapey in the State and District aforesaid in consideration of Two hundred Dollars to me paid by Thomas Terry in the State & District aforesaid, Have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell & release unto the said Tho^s Terry part of tract of Land that was originally granted to John Peden for 1759 acres by a grant bearing date the 6th day of November 1786 situate in the District aforesaid on the flat rock branch waters of Reedy River. Thence part of the tract conveyed to the said Burrell Mapey now from s^d Mapey to s^d Terry. Beginning on a Hickory ^{Ch^o} running N. 86. W. 22. 50. to a red oak thence N. 10. W. 16. Ch^o to a Spanish Oak thence N. 56. W. 17. 50. to a Spanish Oak thence N. 20. W. 31. 50. to a stake thence N. 45. E. 39. Ch^o to a post oak thence S. 24. E. 22. 75 to a stake thence S. 40. W. 16. to a B. Oak thence S. 25. E. 55. 40 to the Beginning, all in that bounds for one hundred and fifty acres of land more or less, Together with all & singular the rights, members, tenements & appurtenances to the said premises, belonging in any way incident or appertaining, To have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Thomas Terry his heirs and assigns forever, and I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Tho^s Terry his heirs and assigns against myself and my heirs and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof - Witness my hand and seal this 22nd day of April in the year of our Lords one thousand Eight hundred & two and in the 26th year of the Independance of the united States of America signed Acknowledged & Delivered in presence of ^{Entered before my hands & seal the 11th day of April 1802} *Benⁿ Brister* Burrell Mapey *E.L.S.* of Just.
