Clain came before me and said in his oath that he was present and did see Burrell Mapes sign and as his act and deed Deliver the within and of conveyance for the use & purposes therein mentioned and that he sees Stephens Crowder with himself assign their names as witnesses to the same - Sworn to and subscribed the day and date above written

Know all men by these presents that I William Smith of Laurens District & State afores^d in consideration of one hundred & fifty dollars to me paid by Thomas Terry of Greenville District and State afores^d Have granted bargained sold & Released and by these presents Do Grant bargain sell and release unto the said Tho^s Terry part of a tract of land that was Originally granted to Benj^m Raney by a grant dated the sixth of October 1782: in Greenville District on Beverly ~~branch~~ Branch water of Steady River then that part of s^d tract lying south side s^d Branch conveyed round to W^m Smiths now from S^d Smith to said Terry the part lying S^d side P^d Branch, from the head Southwards to a post oak on Dicksony line thence on s^d line till it strikes W^m Woods line then down the same to Woods line then on that to Beverly Branch thence to the Beginning - Including the plantation whereon S^d Smith formerly lived with one hundred and sixteen acres of land. Together with all and singular the rights members here detamments & appurtenances to the said premises belonging in any wise Incident or appurtenant, to have to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the s^d Tho^s Terry his heirs & assigns forever, and I do hereby bind myself my heirs Exec^{rs} & adm^{rs} to warrant and forever defend all and singular the s^d premises unto the s^d Tho^s Terry his heirs & assigns against myself and my heirs and against every other person Whomsoever Lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof = =
