This Indenture made this seventeenth day of August, and in the year of our Lord one thousand Eight hundred and Five, Between Thomas Chatman of the State and District above mentioned of the one part and William Stinson of the said State & District of the other part. Witnesseth that the said Thomas Chatman for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred and thirty dollars Lawfull Current money to him in hand well and truly paid by him the said William Stinson at and before the delivery of these presents, the receipt thereof is hereby fully acknowledged that he granted bargain and sold aliened Release confirmed and by these presents do Grant bargain sell alien Release and confirm unto him the said William Stinson his heirs and assigns forever all that part of a certain tract of land containing six hundred and ninety acres originally granted to William Reed and signed by Governor Pinckney on the second day of March 1792: as by a plat thereunto annexed will fully appears all that part of the said tract of land (Beginning)
