Which Pope by this said Charles Pope do warrant and will for ever defende against myself and each and every of my heirs Executors administrators or assigns Whom the said

Richard Pope his heirs and assigns forever Against any persons lawfully Claiming or to claim the said Property or any part thereof. Witness my hand and seal this 31<sup>st</sup> March 1806

James Franks before the Signing & Delivery of these presents the receipt and Payment whereof is hereby Acknowledged. Hath Granted bargained sold and delivered. Aligned, Enfeoffed Conveyed and confirmed and by these Presents doth Grant bargain sell and Deliver Enfeoff Convey & confirm unto the said James Franks his heirs & assigns forever part of a tract of land that was granted to Joseph McDaniel Bounded as follow (Beginning)
