 Greenville District. for and in consideration of the sum of Fifteen hundred dollars
 to me paid by James Blasingame of the Dist: afores^d. Have granted bargained Sold & Released
 and by these presents Do Grant bargain sell & Release unto the said James Blasingame
 a tract or Plantation of lands laying and being in the district afores^d. on both sides of
 Middle Tygar River. Beginning at a red oak and running thence N. 30 E. 35 ch. 40 lb. to a
 Post Oak thence N. 40. W. 45 ch. to a tertiary stake thence N. 39 ch. 30 lb. to a stake
 thence S. 28. W. 43 ch. 60 lb. to a stake thence S 80. E. 74. ch. 40 lb. to the Beginning. Contain-
 -ing Three hundred and eighty eight acres be the same more or less, the same being granted
 by patent bearing date Jan^y 21st 1785. to Michael Miller and by him conveyed to
 Mr Anderson and by him to me. also one other parcel of lands joining the above
 Beginning at the afores^d red oak running S. 60. E. 14 ch. to a post oak near the ridge
 Road that leads from Mrs Lasky up towards Starling Ingramy thence along said Road
