Wood of Greenville district and state aforesaid for and in consideration of the just sum of three hundred dollars to me in hand paid by Enoch Benson of the district and state aforesaid, Have bargained sold & Released and by these presents DO Grant bargain sell and release unto the said Enoch Benson all that tract or parcels of land. Beginning on a post oak corner, north side beverdam creek belonging to S^r Benson thence cross said creek along a conditional line, thence up the meanders of S^r Creek, to the mouth of a branch in the field, Swickwood Corner, thence up said branch to a maple corner, thence a direct course Southwardly to a backline near wolf Creek, thence on said line N^o 63. East to a red oak corner, thence N^o 27. W. to the Beginning, Including within them lines two hundred acres of land - Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise appertaining To Have and To Hold, all singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Enoch Benson his heirs Executors or any of them, to warrant & forever defend, all and singular the said premises unto the said Enoch Benson his heirs and assigns against myself my heirs and against every person whomsoever, Lawfully claiming the same or any part thereof.
