Wolff Merch^t of Laurens District, State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Two Hundred dollars to me paid by William Deverport Planter of said State & District of Greenville, Have granted bargained sold and released, and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said William Deverport all that plantation tract or parcel of lands, containing one hundred and eighty acres (more or less) lying & being in the State aforesaid and District of Greenville on horse creek a branch of Reedy River, bounding N^o 1^o Wardly on Lands of Mr Denny & Wardly lands of Mr Chandler on other sides the owners of the Land unknown it being part of nine hundred acres of Land surveyed for William Wood the 10th day of February 1786, and granted to William Floyd the third of January 1791 by his Excellency Charles Pinckney Esq^r &c. it having such forms marks boundaries & bounding as in the above plat represents, Together with all & singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging in any wise Incident or appertaining To have and to hold all and singular the said premises before mentioned unto the said William Deverport his heirs & assigns forever, and I do hereby bind myself my heirs & administrators, to warrant and forever defend all & singular the said premises unto the said William Deverport his heirs administrators or assigns - In Witness thereof I have set my hand and seal this Eight day of Feb^r in the year of our Lord one thousand Eight hundred and four and in the twenty eight year of the Independance of the United States of America, Signed sealed & delivered in presence
