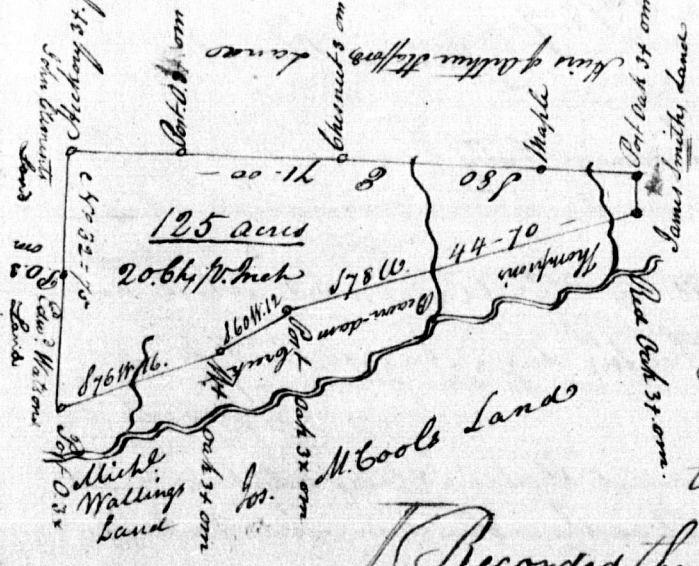


South Carolina, Know all men by these presents, that I Valentine Ponder of Greenville District and State aforesaid, for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred Dollars to me in hand paid by Joseph Davis of the State and district aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, Have Granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do bargain Grant sell and release unto the said Joseph Davis all that tract or parcel of land containing one hundred and twenty five acres it being a tract of land surveyed for him the said Ponder the 22nd day of September in the year 1803. Lying in said district on Branches of Thompsons Beaverdam creek of Middle Tygar river, Bounding by lines tuning S.W. by lands surveyed for Joseph M. Cool Sr. by James Smiths Land N. by heirs of John Clarke and Edward Watson, Land S.E. by heirs of Arthur Staffords Land and S.W. by lands surveyed for Michael Waller and hath such form and marks as the above plot represents, Together with all and singular the rights and hereditaments & appurtenances to the said one hundred and twenty five acres belonging or in any wise appertaining. To have and To hold all and singular the premises before mentioned to the said Joseph Davis his heirs and assigns forever, and I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors & Adm^{rs} To warrant and forever defend all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Joseph Davis his heirs and assigns against myself and all my heirs and against every other person whomsoever lawfully claiming the same or any part thereof.
