This Indenture made the 17th day of June in the year of our Lord one thousand Eight hundred and five, and the twenty ninth year of the Independence of the United States of America, Between John Brashers of the State of South Carolina Greenville District Planter, of the one part, and James Ashmore of the State and district aforesaid Planter, the other part, Witnesseth that the said John Brashers for and in consideration of the sum of Three hundred dollars to him in hand paid the said James Ashmore at once before the enrolling and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged Have granted bargained aliened released and confirmed and by these presents doth Grant bargain sell alien release confirm unto the said James Ashmore in his actual possession now being by virtue of a bargain & seal to him thereof made forever from the day of the date hereof and by force of the Statute for Transferring use into possession and to his heirs and assigns forever, all that plantation tract or parcel of land containing by Estimation one hundred and Twenty acres of land be the same more or less situated lying and in District of Ninety Six and in Greenville County on Cripple Creek waters of reedy river, it being part of a certain tract of land originally granted to James White containing five hundred acres and duly conveyed to Thomas Brasher Recorded in Greenville Book page 184 & 185 and willed to said John Brashers by said Thomas Brashers his father Granted by his Excellency Benjamin Gurard Governor and Commander in chief in and over said State at Charleston the patent bearing date the twenty fifth of January in the year of our Lord one thousand Seven hundred Eighty five, the lines of said land being condition Between themselves two part of the original said land, it beginning on a pine stake and running the old line, to a conditional corner, to the beginning corner a pine Stake, — Together with all houses out houses buildings fences woods underwoods ways paths passages water courses ponds lakes fishings ways and all appurtenances as whatsoever the said plantation tract of land belonging or appertaining, and the reversion & Remainder and remainders rents Issues and profits of all and singular s^d premises with their heirs of their appurtenances and also all the Estate right title Interest and demand whatsoever both in Law and Equity of him the said John Brashers of in. to, the same and every part & parcel thereof with their appurtenances, to have and to hold all and singular the s^d plantation tract of one hundred and twenty acres be the same more or less — Hereditaments premises & appurtenances above mentioned and every part thereof unto the said James Ashmore
