W 63. 2 1/2 to a Stake, thence S. 80 E. 31 1/2 to a Red oak, thence S. 10. E. 63. 2 1/2 to a white oak, thence S. 80. W 31. 6 1/2 to the beginning, Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and Appertinances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining; to have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said John Alexander his heirs and assigns forever and I do hereby bind my self my heirs Executors and Administrators to Warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said John Alexander his heirs assigns against my self my heirs and against Every person whomsoever Lawfully claiming or to blame the same on any part thereof.
