~~This Indenter made this Twentyseventh Day of December in the year of our Lord Eighteen hundred & two between Edward Stringer of the one part and Michael Forrest of the other part both of the State of South Carolina and District of Greenville witnesseth that said Edward Stringer for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred dollars to him in hand well and truly paid and before the signing and delivering of this presents hath bargained granted and sold and by of these presents doth bargain grant and sell unto the above sd Michael Forrest a certain tract or parcel of land containing Fifty Acres more or less situated lying and being in the State and district above said on the bank side of the South fork of the three forks of Tyger it being a part of a tract of land originally granted to many persons by his Excellency William Moultrie in the years one thousand seven hundred and eighty even having the following~~

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State of South Carolina, I know all men by these Presents that I John Thomas of Greenville District, in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of three hundred dollars paid by John Thomas (son of Robert) of the State and district aforesaid, have granted bargained sold & released and by these Presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said John Thomas (son of Robert) all that tract or Parcel of Land lying on the south side of South fork of Tyger river, begining on a Gum on the bank of the river, running S. by W. along Robert Carter's line of forty acres (herefore conveyed out of the same tract of which the above bargained tract is a part) to a Stake in a piece of cleared ground, thence S 87^r. E. the out line of said land crossing clear creek four times to a Dead Hickory corner to said Tract, thence N. 7^r. E. to the river, and thence up the meanders of said river to the begining: being part of a tract of six hundred and forty acres and all that lies on the south side the river of said tract (except forty acres already conveyed to Robert Carter) Containing three hundred acres be the same more or less. Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appertenances to the ~~30~~ three hundred acres of Land belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining to house and to hold all and singular the premises before aforesaid unto the said John Thomas son of Robert his heirs and assigns forever and I do hereby bind my self my heirs and
