Thomas Deen a tract or parcel of Land containing Seventy acres more or less Situate in the district of greenville on the south side of the middle fork of the Kedy fork of Kedy River beginning at a post oak standing on the Original line of Land granted to Lodwallander Jones it being the corner of a part of the same tract conveyed by the S. Vicroy to Benjamin Armstrong running thence S.W. 40:42:50. to a post oak corner thence S.E. 30: 11: 50: as James Deats line to a stake thence N.E. on a stream Greenman's Line to a post oak made by the S. Deen & John Simmons separating of a part of the tract conveyed to the sd. Deen by the before mentioned John Simmons from thence on a conditional line of mark & trees to a stake to where a second conditional line of mark & trees joins it leading from the beginning corner separating of armstrongs Land it being a part of a tract Originally granted To James Harrison and signed by this Ex Cellency William moultrie on the second day of december one thousand seven hundred and thirty three the above bounds including Seventy acres more or less with all and singular the Rights members heridatements and appertuances to the S. Deen's premises belonging or in any wise Incident or appertaining, To have and to hold all and singularly the premises before mentioned unto the S. Thomas Deen his heirs and assigns forever and I do hereby bind my self my heirs Executors administrators and assigns to warrant and forever defend all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the S. Thomas Deen his heirs and assigns against my self my heirs and assigns and all and every other person or persons whatsoever Laying any claim to a part or parts thereof. in witness whereof I do hereunto set my hand and seal this 16 day of March one thousand eight hundred and seven.
