And I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors and administrators to warrant and defend the above mentioned Premises unto the said Edward Dill his heirs and assigns forever, against me and my heirs and against every Person whomsoever claiming or to claim lawfully the same or any Part thereof - In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this twenty eighth day of February in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and seven, and thirty first year of American Independence. Situate in the state and district ^{opposite} on the Sth side of Guiliars Creek Waters of Coosa river, Including the Plantation whereon the said Hannah Johnson now lives Boarding on the N. by Sam'l Kilgores land, on the E. by John Westmoreland & on the S. & W. by said William Johnson's land, Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments & appurtenances thereto belonging or in any wise incident thereto.
