Have bargained sold granted and Released, and by these Presents do grant bargain
sell and Release unto the said Jordan Holcombe a plantation or tract of land lying &
being in the District ofesaica on both sides of Jacobs Creek a branch of S^t. Sugar
River, Beginning at a lightwood Stake corner, agreed on Thomas Barton & William Calloway
now Andrew M. George corner, and running thence N. 30. W. 45 Ch. 24 Pk. to a Spanish
Oak thence N. 60. E. 30. Ch. 62 links to a post oak, thence S. 30. E. 45 Ch. 24 links. And
thence to the Beginning-Corner, containing by Estimation one hundred & Fifty acres be-
the same more or less being a part of a tract of Land granted to Thomas Barton
by pattern bearing date 15th day of October 1784. for two hundred acres and whereon the
said Cox now lives - Together with all and singular The Rights members, Hereditaments
and appurtenances to the said Premises belonging or in any wise appertaining -
To Have and To Hold all and singular the premises above mentioned unto the
said Jordan Holcombe His Heirs and assigns forever; And I do hereby bind
myself my heirs Executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all
and singular the said Premises unto the said Jordan Holcombe His Heirs & assigns
