Secretaries office, Book c.c.c. & Page 123. Granted by his Excellency Thomas
Pinckney Esq^r. Beginning at a mapole xiii near Hollands ford binding on Samuel
Cosen's land, thence running N.E. to a post oak xii thence South East on Maxwell's line
the Dividing line of Kelly's at a Stake xiii thence to the head of a branch thence down
the various courses of the branch to Saluda river, thence up the various Courses of
the River to the beginning corner - Together with all and singular the rights mem-
bers Hereditaments and appurtenances to the said Premises belonging or in any
wise incident or appertaining. To Have and To Hold all and singular the Pre-
mises before mentioned unto the said young Eskew his heirs & assigns forever - and
I Samuel Cosen do hereby bind myself my heirs & assigns to warrant & forever defend
all and singular the said Premises unto the said young Eskew his heirs & assigns
against myself my heirs Executors & Administrators & against every Person lawfully
claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof. Witness my hand & seal this
