Situated in Greenville District aforesaid, on Reedy River, and runs as follows. that is to say. Beginning on a post oak and runs straight to a turkey oak, and from thence to a black Jack and from thence along the old original line to a red oak and from thence to a post oak & from thence to a post oak, and from thence to George Tubb spring branch, thence of said branch as a conditional line to a Pusimow & from thence a conditional line to a red oak on the head of a branch of Reedy river and down said branch to the old original line, & thence said line to the Beginning. Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenance to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining.
