State of South Carolina, I know all men by these presents that I Joseph Duncan of Greenville County and State aforesaid, for and in consideration of the sum of two hundred dollars to me paid Jepse P. Poole of the State and County aforesaid, Have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Jepse P. Poole a tract or parcel of land containing Eighty acres be the same more or less, situate in Greenville County on the north side of the Enoee River, run as follows Beginning at the River on Griffing line, thence along Griffing line to a large Pine nearly the same course to a post oak on Cannadys line thence South twelve degrees east thence three chain fifty links to a white oak thence South Eastly six degrees west twenty chains to a dog wood, on the bank of said river thence up said river to the Beginning — Together with all and singular the rights, members hereditaments & appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise appertaining: To Have and To Hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Jepse P. Poole his heirs Executors or any of them, to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Poole his heirs and assigns against myself my heirs and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming the same or any part thereof — Witness my hand and seal this 25th of September 1807.
