The State of South Carolina: Know all men by these presents that I John Cox of Greenville District in the State aforesaid, for in consideration of the three Hundred Dollars to me in hand paid by Henry Oldham of the State and district aforesaid, I the said John Cox have granted bargained & sold & Released & by these presents do grant bargain sell and Release unto the said Henry Oldham all that tract or parcel of land, situate in the State & district aforesaid, on both sides of maple creek waters of Enoree river, suppose to contain one hundred and twenty nine acres more or less, It Being a part of a tract of six hundred and forty acres originally granted to Margaret Cox the twenty first day of January one thousand seven hundred & eighty five & Recorded in grant book - Act A. A. page 444: the land to be conveyed is as follows. Beginning on a Stake on the original line on the west side of said creek. run through S^t. tract N. 44-11.55 chains to a hickory st, thence to a B. Gum st on the north side of said creek near the mouth of a small branch a dividing branch between said John Cox of Joshua Cox lands and run up the meander of said branch to maple & on Bowers & Griffis line S.55. E. on original line to a hickory st on thence S.25- W.49. ch. to white oak near said creek S.35. W. over said creek to the Beginning Stake &c. which include the land to be conveyed be the same more or less. Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments & appurtenances thereto or in any wise incident or appertaining therunto to the only use & behoof of him the said Henry Oldham his heirs, Executors, administrators and assigns, against myself my heirs, Executors, Administrators and no further. Witness my hand and Seal the 28th day of March 1808 — and in the 32nd year of the Independence of the United States of America —
