The State of South Carolina: Know all men by these presents that I John  
Cox of Greenville District in the State aforesaid, for in consideration of the  
three Hundred Dollars to me in hand paid by Henry Oldham of the State  
and district aforesaid, I the said John Cox have granted bargained & sold  
& Released & by these presents do grant bargain sell and Release unto the  
said Henry Oldham all that tract or parcel of land, Situate in the State & district  
aforesaid, on both sides of maple creek waters of Enace river, supposed to contain  
one hundred and twenty nine acres more or less, It Being a part of a tract of six  
hundred and forty acres originally granted to Margaret Cook the twenty first day  
of January one thousand seven hundred & eighty five Recorded in grant book  
At the 4<sup>th</sup> page 441: the land to be conveyed is as follows. Beginning on a stake  
on the original line on the west side of said creek. run through 3<sup>rd</sup> tract N. 44-  
W. 55 chains to a hickory 3<sup>rd</sup>, thence to a B Gum 6<sup>th</sup> on the north side of said creek  
near the mouth of a small branch a dividing branch between said John Cox  
& Joshua Cox lands, and runs up the meander of said branch to maple 3<sup>rd</sup> on  
Bowers & Griffin's line S. 5. E. on original line to a hickory 3<sup>rd</sup> on thence S. 25-  
W. 49. Ch. to white oak near said creek S. 35. W. over said creek to the Beginning  
Stake Co. which includy the land to be conveyed be the same more or  
less. Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments &  
appurtenances therunto or in any wise incident or appertaining therunto  
to the only use & behoof of him the said Henry Oldham his heirs, Executors  
administrators and assigns, against myself my heirs, Executors, administrators  
and no further. Witness my hand and Seal this 28<sup>th</sup> day of March 1808 —  
and in the 32<sup>nd</sup> year of the Independance of the United States of
