Have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said William Thurston Sen. one hundred acres of land lying and being in the district aforesaid, it being part of a tract of land purchased by the said Robertson from John Ford Esq. Beginning at a red oak in youngs line thence N. by W. to a pine 10: 88: thence west with bearing 27: 92: to a Stake thence South 35: W. on a Quagga 13 Chain to a Stake thence E by S Chain to a Stake in Youngs line. thence to the Beginning, Together with all and singular the rights members hereafterments & appurtenances to the Premises, Belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining. To Have & To Hold all and singular the premises unto the said W^m Thurston Sen. his heirs & assigns forever I do hereby bind myself my heirs &c to warrant and forever defend all all and singular the premises unto the said Thurston his heirs &c against myself my heirs &c and every other person or persons whatsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof; Witness our hands & seals this 28th day of December 1801.
