Know all men by these presents, that I John Lynch Weaver of Greenville District and State aforesaid, for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred Dollars to me in hand paid by Aaron Swaffer of the State and District aforesaid. Have granted bargained sold and released, and by these presents Do Grant bargain sell and Release and confirm unto the said Aaron Swaffer all that tract of land being in Greenville District, on the rail Cabin Branch of South Tyger river, Beginning on a red oak a conditional corner between the Widow Langford and s<sup>r</sup> John Lynch Weaver, running S<sup>o</sup> on a conditional line to the mouth of a branch near the Greenville road thence up the said branch to the head, on a black oak corner thence W. to a post oak corner thence N.W. to a dead white oak corner, on the branch thence N.E. to the Beginning corner - same lands being part of a tract conveyed from Mrs. Tubbs Sew. to the said John Lynch Weaver, on the fourteenth of July one thousand seven hundred & ninety seven, the same being one hundred acres, more or less, WITH all and singular the rights, members, Hereditaments, and appertinences, to the said Premises belonging or in any wise appertaining, To have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned to the s<sup>r</sup> Aaron Swaffer his heirs and assigns forever, and I do hereby bind myself my heirs, Executors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend all and singular the s<sup>d</sup> premises unto the s<sup>r</sup> Aaron Swaffer his heirs and assigns against myself my heirs or against any other person or persons whatsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof. In Witness whereof I have set my hand, & affixed my seal this third day of March one thousand Eight hundred & eight, and the thirty second year of American Independence signed sealed & delivered in presence of us
